## Rules for the Allocation of Funds from the *Cooperatio* Programme in 2023

ETF UK is involved in two research areas included in the *Cooperatio* research institutional support programme at Charles University: Theology and Religious Studies (THEO) and Sociology and Applied Social Sciences (SOAS). The work of the academics from the Department of Social Work falls under SOAS, while the activities carried out by the academics and researchers from the Faculty's other departments and institutes falls under THEO.

The following rules are provided within the meaning of Articles 3 and 4 of the Principles of the Cooperatio Programme (Rector's Directive No. 18/2021, "Principles"):

- 1. 8% of the total amount is allocated to the tools for the support of the strategic priorities of ETF within creative activities.
- 2. 92% of the total amount is allocated to activities within the two research areas in which ETF is involved within the Cooperatio programme.
- 3. The division of funds between THEO and SOAS at the Faculty is based on the calculation of the proportion of the FTEs of the employees involved, taking into consideration the total amount of the corresponding labour costs. Based on the calculation of the current proportions of the FTEs and labour costs between employees involved in THEO and SOAS, the funds for 2023 are allocated 10:1, that is, 83.65% for THEO and 8.35% for SOAS.
- 4. The use of funds for the support of the strategic priorities within creative activities is approved by the Dean. The use of funds for THEO is approved by the Vice-Dean for Science. The use of funds for SOAS is approved by the head of the Department of Social Work.

These Rules were approved by the Academic Senate of ETF UK at its meeting of 23 May 2023.
