

Dean's Directive No. 3/2024

## **Faculty Crisis Staff**

- 1. The following Crisis Staff of the Protestant Theological Faculty (hereinafter referred to as the "CS") is hereby established to deal with emergency situations and crises at the Faculty:
  - Dean (head of the CS);
  - Secretary to the Faculty (deputy head of the CS);
  - Vice Dean for Development;
  - Vice Dean for Foreign and Ecumenical Relations;
  - Pastor for students;
  - Building manager;
  - OHS officer; and
  - Information Technologies manager.
- 2. The CS is an advisory body to the Dean. Its purpose is the effective and timely management of crisis situations such as dangerous situations caused by natural disasters or persons, serious conflicts, etc.
- 3. The CS meets as necessary; it is convened by the head of the CS or by his/her deputy, or possibly by another of its members who has become aware of a crisis situation.
- 4. Depending on the nature of the crisis situation, the head may decide not to convene the CS in its entirety or may invite other persons to participate in the CS.
- 5. The CS cooperates with the Security and Occupational Safety Department of Charles University and the Crisis Staff of Charles University as needed.
- 6. The current staff composition of the CS, including the contact details of the members, forms an appendix to this Directive and is available on the public website of the Faculty.
