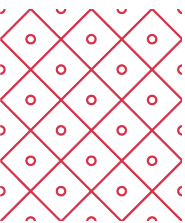

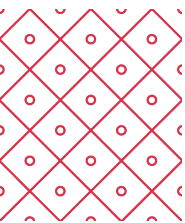
In the programme there is still space enough for lectures or workshops given by incoming teachers, the google form contains boxes to put the title and annotation of your contribution.

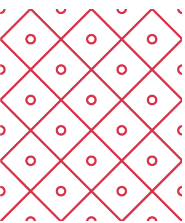
