Accommodation in Prague

You will be allocated a place in the University halls of residence if you ask for this in the online application. All rooms are shared between two students. Details, including prices, can be found on the website of Charles University European Office here. More details will be sent to you with the letter of acceptance you receive from the European Office. Places in the university halls of residence are allocated by Charles University European Office and all questions about this should be addressed to them at erasmus[at]ruk.cuni.cz

Erasmus students and students receiving a scholarship on the basis of bilateral governmental agreements are allocated a place in the University student dormitories (sharing with another student) if they ask for this in their application. For other students, the Office for International Relations can also arrange a place for you in the University student dormitories. Information about the student dormitories and student canteens can be found here.

Of course if you prefer you can find your own accommodation. Unfortunately there is no university or faculty accommodation agency. There are many commercial agencies which can be found on the internet, but also, unfortunately, a few frauds, so be sensible. Alternatively you could stay in a hostel or other temporary accommodation to start with and look for more permanent accommodation after you arrive.
