


As good as state ©

- Universities supported by member churches of the EKD / by dioceses and associations
- Financing depending on federal state with church share 5% to 50%, state share about 40% to 95%
- Church HS are all "SAGE universities": Social work, health, education

Bachelor's Programme Social Work / Social Pedagogy



In professional circles in German speaking countries, "Soziale Arbeit" is the umbrella term commonly used for the fields of Social Work and Social Education / Social Pedagogy.

- A large variety of working areas are opened up to those studying with us: school social work; supporting the homeless, people with disabilities or addiction problems; helping migrants and asylum seekers; caring for the elderly or dementia patients and their relatives; social work with offenders – to name but a few.
- A new addition to our courses that students can opt for as part of the Social Work programme is "International Social Work", which
 conveys insights into social work and its conditions in other countries as well as discussing international and transnational
 perspectives. Students will also gain intercultural competencies.
- Studying for only three more semesters gives you the option to complete a Bachelor degree in Religious Education as well. Those
 wishing to expand upon selected competencies can opt for additional qualifications: Experiential and Environmental Education,
 SPOSA Sport and Social Work, RECOS Social Work in Germany / France / Switzerland, and Art Education.
- The Bachelor degree can be followed by the research-oriented Master's programme in Social Work.
- Dual qualification possible: the Bachelor programmes Social Work and Religious Education and Diaconia are structured in the same way and also show many similarities in terms of content. Within the course of three additional semesters, a degree in the other programme of study can be obtained as well.

Religious Education and Diaconia



- The Bachelor's programme Religious Education and Diaconia provides a qualification for a very diverse career revolving around the human being and around generating meaning. The degree opens up great opportunities for working in German regional protestant and in free churches: as a deacon, you can work in a church, diaconate or school with people of different age groups as well as varying personal circumstances and living environments, for example. Or you can teach religious studies at schools up to and including lower secondary education (ISCED 2).
- By adding a period of study shortened to only three semesters you can obtain a dual qualification with a second Bachelor degree in Social Work. The practical work placement offers the option to concentrate on the international perspective of ecclesiastical work.
- Only at the EH Freiburg: unique throughout Germany, we have initiated the project "Intergenerational Living and Learning", as
 part of which Religious Education students have the chance to live in a retirement home in affordable modern apartments,
 combined with social learning.
- With our additional qualifications, you will gain competencies in selected areas: Healthcare and Preventive Care, Experiential
 and Environmental Education, Art Education, Sport Education (SPOSA).
- Dual qualification possible: the Bachelor's Programmes Social Work and Religious Education and Diaconia are structured in the same way and also show many similarities in terms of content. Within the course of three additional semesters, a degree in the other study programmes can be obtained as well.

<u>Internationally connected - networks</u>



Cooperation with universities in Germany and abroad in the areas of teaching, research, transfer: 4 examples

- Teaching, research and transfer cooperative RECOS: e.g. child protection in the border region Germany/ France/
 Switzerland. Result: Vademecum; avoid external placement in child and youth welfare. Project co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) in the framework of the Interreg (V) Upper Rhine program.
- International profile BA SozArb; English language modules; structured Student Mobility (top position in CHE!)
- Exchange with 35 colleges and universities, e.g. University of Iowa, prevention of anti-Semitism, human rights education
- Teaching cooperation in the field of peace education (e.g. University in Capetown, topic: Female Refugees and Migrants in South Africa)

Close to practice in teaching, research, transfer



Practical placements for students of all bachelor's degree programs – Practical phases are part of the studies and are supervised by professors.

Above all, numerous cooperations with institutions of the social and health care system are established, about 140 practice positions in the BA Social:
