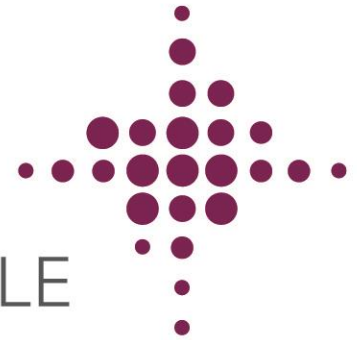

Definition: International Federation of Social Workers:

“Social work is a practice-based profession and an academic discipline that promotes social change and development, social cohesion, and the empowerment and liberation of people.

Principles of social justice, human rights, collective responsibility and respect for diversities are central to social work.

Underpinned by theories of social work, social sciences, humanities and indigenous knowledge, social work engages people and structures to address life challenges and enhance wellbeing.

OUR AIMS

1. Be able to connect social work science and practice.
2. To be able to adopt and use the perspectives of different reference disciplines (transdisciplinarity).
3. everyday relevance and lifeworld orientation: being able to interweave psychosocial and socio-structural perspectives.
4. deepen key qualifications: being able to deal with diversity -
Aesthetic, cultural and communicative competence

5. acting in social work organizations: being able to tap economic, political and legal resources.
6. acting professionally in social work: being able to use knowledge of values, explanations, observations and interventions to plan actions
7. being able to reflect on one's own value orientation in the context of value knowledge

FORMALITITES

- Start of studies: in the winter semester (beginning of October each year).
- Voluntary social year or other internships increase your chances when applying to our university.
- Number of study places per year: approx. 140
- Duration: 7 semesters, including one semester of internship
- Tuition fees: 280 € per semester
- Degree: "State-recognized social worker / social pedagogue"

SOCIAL WORK AS A JOB

Social work is a versatile and varied profession.

Social workers are active in about 60 fields of activity.

Due to social and economic change, new tasks are constantly being added (e.g. migration, demographic change).
