Rita McLeod studied psychology at the Philosophical Faculty of Charles University in Prague. In 1987, she moved to Saskatoon, Canada, where she worked over 20 years as an educational psychologist, mostly with First Nations children. In 1992, she was commissioned to translate the Czech opera *Brundibar* into English and in 2004 she decided to produce it in Saskatoon, with the Saskatoon Children's Choir. In 2006, she became the choir's General Manager.

In 2016, she translated into English her mother's memoirs, *Someone Made a Mistake, So I am Here Now.* Rita McLeodová has accompanied her mother, Dr. Dagmar Lieblová, to conferences, seminars and talks with students, in the Czech Republic, Germany, Spain, as well as in Western Canada, while Dr. Lieblová shares her experiences during the Holocaust.
